All youth aged 14 and 15 and working on a farm or ranch other than their own *MUST* be certified through a Hazardous Occupations Course. Successful completion of the course will allow trained youth to operate an approximately 20 PTO horsepower tractor, or to connect or disconnect an implement or any of its parts to or from a tractor.
