CONFRONTING CROPPING CHALLENGES

Confronting Cropping Challenges meetings give you an opportunity to learn from the challenges you might have faced this past growing season by going more in depth about issues we experienced in 2023. Topics that will be focused on this year are herbicide resistant weeds, white mold, and corn rootworm resistance.

This is a 2.5 hour program that costs \$10. In addition, you can also stay for the last session (additional 1 hour) and recertify your private pesticide applicator license.

We only offer recertification, no initial training. Pesticide recertification costs an additional \$60.

PRIVATE PESTICIDE RECERTIFICATION

This is not your only opportunity to recertify your private applicator certification. Nebraska Extension will be hosting traditional private pesticide trainings in your area in January – April.

These training will be roughly 2 to 3 hours long and will cost \$60. Training dates are currently being finalized, but you will be receiving more information about these dates in December or January. Or visit pested.unl.edu/certification-and-training for training dates.

We wanted to let you know that there are updates to the private pesticide safety training that may impact your operation in 2024. These changes are in accordance with changes to the Nebraska Pesticide Act.

Hard copies of EC 130 "2024 Guide for Weed, Disease and Insect Management in Nebraska" are available for purchase at: marketplace.unl.edu website for \$35 plus shipping.

- Your new license will indicate that you received private pesticide safety training with the words "General Agriculture" and/or a code (00) printed on it. If you choose to get certified in either Soil or Non-Soil/Structural Fumigation (see below), your license will show these as 01a and 11, respectively. Your new license will be a tan color.

- If you wish to use soil fumigants, you will be required to pass the commercial/non commercial Soil Fumigation (category 01a) exam to receive this certification.

- If you wish to use non-soil, structural, or rodent burrow fumigants, you will be required to pass the commercial/noncommercial Non-Soil/Structural Fumigation (category 11) exam to receive this certification.
