

Field to Market Field Assessment to Improve Efficiency

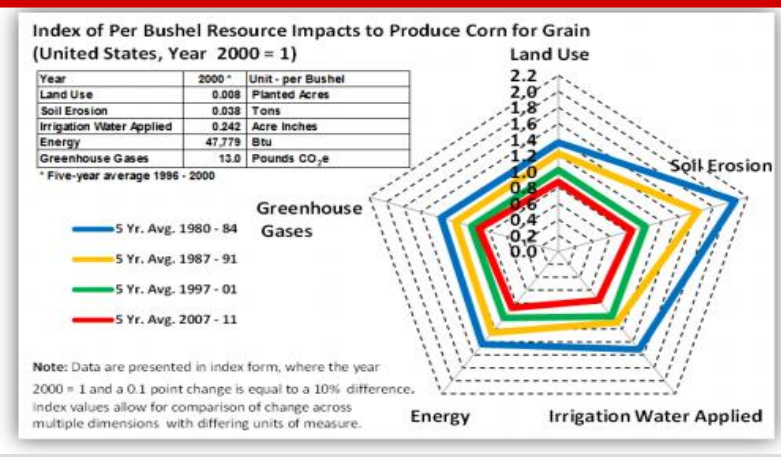
This workshop will use the Field to Market tool which uses farming practices and other production data to produce graphs and tables which enable a farm to quantify the total resources used in production. Funding, in part, is being provided by the Nebraska Corn and Soybean Boards.

Why Participate?

- Quantify several environmental indicators *that also effect profit* of a field.
- Compare production efficiency with your peers (all data remaining confidential).
- Visualize the production process in a new way helping to expose areas of efficiency and inefficiency.
- Identify opportunities to improve efficiency and sustainability.

The Future:

- This type of tool may be used to document the sustainability of a field or farm allowing access to grain markets which require such documentation.

- Help you establish sustainability benchmarks with science based, outcome focused metrics.
- Keep you on the cutting edge of producers learning about new, food supply chain sustainability initiatives with water and energy.
